CLARIFICATIONS

1. The attached bid proposal form has been revised to include an additional bid alternate.

Bid Alternate No. 6: **Fiber Optic Cable** - One of the conduits in bid alternate No. 4 shall be provided with a fiber optic cable, type OM4, multi-mode, 10-strand, direct burial rated. Contractor shall provide a compatible fiber optic patch panel wall mounted in the concession building electrical room. Contractor shall terminate the cable in this panel and in the existing fiber panel in the existing IDF off of the Gym in the main building. Contractor shall terminate with type LC connectors and test all strands in accordance with TIA/EIA-568.
