Reports of the Committees and Liaisons

Masuk Student Representatives

Student Representative Gupta said that that exams started for seniors on Friday and underclassman exams will be begin on Thursday. The Senior Breakfast will be next Tuesday morning. In sports, Volleyball and Softball teams are in the State semi-finals, and the State Opens for track were held today.

CES

Board Member Reinoso went to the CES meeting last Thursday and said that they were provided with a summary of the legislative issues that were addressed by CES this past session. He shared a copy of the Impact Summary with the Board of Education Members. Board Member Reinoso added that Evan Pitkoff's contract has been extended as head of CES.

Public Participation

There was none at tonight's meeting.

Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Agostine said that most positions have been filled though they will need to fill the position vacated by Darlene Fensore.

Superintendent Agostine stated that Turf Field Committee has had several meetings, and the decision has been made to relocate all outdoor activities offsite during the construction phase. The anticipated start date is June 15, and there will be a groundbreaking ceremony. The topsoil will be going to the Town and to Stepney Elementary. Superintendent Agostine added there was a pre-construction meeting today at Town Hall with the departments and individuals who will be involved with the project. He also asked for the Board's approval to order the lighting for the Turf Field now, as it is included in the bonding and the bonding authorizes going forward with them. The Board was in agreement.

Board Member Guttmann asked if there is a contingency in case the road was damaged when moving the heavy equipment. There is and it was noted that a bridge will be built across the track to prevent damage. The Stepney oil tank replacement should be finalized at the next Town Council meeting.

Superintendent Agostine reported that they had a first meeting with Garland in preparation of the next bonding project, which will be the replacement of the Stepney roof, scheduled for Summer 2017. Garland has advised that, in order to get the best price on a project of this size, an RFP should go out in January.

Superintendent Agostine said that a sizable limb fell at Monroe Elementary, and they have begun an aggressive tree trimming project. They will be very aggressive in taking down all the trees in the playground and pre-school playground.

Presentations

Perkins Innovation Grant - *Mark Schwarz*, Masuk High School Assistant Principal. *Mark Schwarz* asked for the Board of Education's permission and approval to move forward on a grant opportunity in the Career and Technical Education Department. He said that it requires Board of Education support to move forward, and the deadline is Friday, June 10. The Grant is an innovation grant, up to \$30,000, which offers federal money to be distributed by the State Department of Education to schools in the State.

Last year, the Career and Technical Education Department asked for and received a grant to support the development of Banking and Finance, a new course that will be offered in the fall. The Perkins Innovation Grant will provide funding to make improvements to a school store in the high school and to the Career and Technical Education programs that support the school. *Mr. Schwarz* said the funds can be used to improve infrastructure in the store or to get items that can be used in the classroom for instruction beyond just supporting the school store. Some of the opportunities include the purchase of 3-D printers, mannequins, new signage, and security items. The Board agreed to amend the
